



Maniti Eco-Lodge Maniti Odyssey 4 Days / 3 Nights

*Please note that the below itinerary is intended as a guideline only.
The Maniti Lodge staff reserve the right to amend the itinerary in accordance with climatic
and river conditions ... and other operational considerations.*

DAY 1

- Morning departure from Iquitos City by car to the port of **Nanay** (Bellavista) ... where the Nanay River meets the Amazon River.
- After departing by boat, we will travel downriver for 70 km (43 miles), a journey of about 2 hours.
- During the riverboat trip we will have a great possibility of seeing caimans, turtles, herons, pink river dolphins, snakes, and many other species of flora and fauna along the riverbank.
- **Monkey Island** – a small island about 15 minutes from Maniti Lodge, which shelters a large number of monkeys in their natural habitat.
- During our visit on the island we have the unique opportunity to observe and interact with a wide variety of monkeys that include: *Goeldi's monkey, Tamarin monkey, Capuchin monkey, Yellow-Handed Titi monkey, Masked Titi monkey, Cebidae monkey, Woolly monkey, Squirrel monkey, Spider monkey, South American Coati monkey.*
- Along with the various species of monkeys you will have the opportunity to hold very large Anacondas, Boas ... and interact with the unique and rare *Amazonian mata-mata turtle.*
- At Monkey Island we will also see sloths, alligators, turtles, toucans, macaws, parrots etc.
- **Dolphin watching** session at the camp where we will have the unique opportunity to see the [pink freshwater dolphin](#).
- If we are lucky we will also have the chance to **swim** near them in the Amazon River.
- In the evening we will go on a **nocturnal nature hike** to see what types of species we can find (lizards, snakes, spiders, monkeys).
- Overnight at Maniti Eco-Lodge
- *Meals included: Lunch, Dinner*

DAY 2

- We will begin our day early, waking up in time to see the **sunrise over the Amazon River**
- After breakfast, we go on an **animal observation excursion** (by boat) during which we will have the opportunity to see various types of flora and fauna.
- Afternoon **fishing excursion** by boat with opportunity to catch piranha, catfish & other species of fish.
- Viewing of **Victoria Regia water lilies** – the largest freshwater aquatic plant in the world.
- After sunset, we will go on a canoe excursion to spot and catch **caiman**. We will have the opportunity to take photos of the caiman.
- Overnight at Maniti Eco-Lodge.
- *Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

DAY 3

- Morning jungle hike (30-45 minutes) to **Palo Alto**.
- *Palo Alto Mirador* is a lookout point that has three different observation deck levels. Here guests have a **bird's-eye view** of the lowland Peruvian Amazon from 5, 10 and 15 m (16, 33 & 49 ft) above ground.
- We can spend the night here (optional), whilst enjoying excellent opportunities to observe various species in their natural habitat.
- Daytime exploration of the area that includes hiking, canoe ride in lagoon, fishing (depending on passenger preference).
- In the evening we will go on a **night time nature walk** to see what types of species can be seen (reptiles, spiders, monkeys).
- Overnight on the **top observation deck** of *Palo Alto* (in a tent or in hammocks).
- *Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

DAY 4

- **Early morning jungle hike** where we will have the unique opportunity to see a vast number of monkeys, birds, and many other wildlife in their natural habitat. We will also see and learn about various types of Amazonian plants.
- Departure from Maniti Lodge by motorboat to **Iquitos**.
- On the way, we visit a [Yagua](#) **village** to learn and observe about their history and customs.
- Transfer to Iquitos airport or hotel.
- End of service.
- *Meals included: Breakfast*
