



AMAZON STAR: 4-DAY / 3 NIGHT ITINERARY: WEDNESDAY TO SATURDAY

DAY 1 | WEDNESDAY - IQUITOS ARRIVAL & AMAZON STAR BOARDING / PAWACHIRO STREAM

Our crew welcome you on arrival at the city of Iquitos. We then drive to the riverside city of [Nauta](#) where the *Amazon Star* awaits us.

Along the way, we stop off at the **Amazon Rescue Center** (CREA), a foundation dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation and release of manatees.

Once aboard the *Amazon Star*, there is an **orientation and safety talk**.

In the afternoon, we explore **Pawachiro Stream** by boat. This is an area particularly rich in flora.

Upon our return to the *Amazon Star*, the crew will give a musical performance, before dinner.

DAY 2 | THURSDAY – PUCATE RIVER / NAUTA CAÑO STREAM

This morning, we visit Pucate River by boat, taking our picnic breakfast with us. As well as observing the monkeys, birds, and the immense variety of fauna that inhabits the area, we also have the chance to jump in the river, where we are often accompanied by **pink river dolphins**. There is also a **fishing activity** that you can join in.

We return to the *Amazon Star* for lunch and to hear a guide talk about the source of the Amazon River.

In the afternoon, we explore *Nauta Caño*, with the option of gently paddling along the stream in a **kayak**.

Then, after dinner, we can go on another night excursion, where we may be able to spot **caimans** lying on the river banks.





DAY 3 | FRIDAY - PUERTO PRADO VILLAGE / FAREWELL DINNER

Breakfast on board.

In the morning, we go on a walking tour to have direct contact with nature, including the giant **Victoria Regia water lilies**, a remarkable plant native to the Amazon

In Puerto Prado, we pay a visit to the local **shaman**, who will perform a ritual to fill us with good energy.

We return to the boat for an al fresco lunch (weather permitting) followed by a **cooking class** to learn more about the local gastronomy.

If you wish to broaden your mind further, another optional class is in **creative towel-folding!**

Our final boat ride departs in the late afternoon, to enjoy a colourful **sunset ... with champagne.**

Back on the *Amazon Star*, we have a farewell dinner where we can say goodbye to the crew who have served us so well.

DAY 4 | SATURDAY - DISEMBARKATION OF AMAZON STAR

We wake up early in order to disembark after breakfast, in good time to catch our outbound flight from Iquitos.
