



AMAZON STAR: 5-DAY / 4 NIGHT ITINERARY: SATURDAY TO WEDNESDAY

DAY 1 | SATURDAY - CITY TOUR & AMAZON STAR BOARDING

Our crew welcome you on arrival at the city of Iquitos. We then begin the tour by visiting some of the attractions in the area, such as the **Amazon Rescue Center** (CREA), a foundation dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation and release of manatees; the **Museum of Amazonian Indigenous Cultures** and **Casa Morey**, built between 1910 and 1913, an example of the ostentatious architectural style favoured during the Rubber Boom era.

After the tour, we transfer to the port to embark the *Amazon Star*. There is an **orientation and safety talk**, as we begin to sail up the Amazon River.

In the evening, we enjoy a welcome dinner while the activities for the following day are presented.

DAY 2 | SUNDAY – AMAZON RIVER

Early in the morning, we can head to the deck for an optional **bird watching** activity. Peru contains the second highest number of bird species in the world, and the Amazon is home to many of them.

After a delicious breakfast, we go on a **boat exploration** along the Amazon River to see the local vegetation and wildlife.

Upon return, lunch is served. A naturalist guide will give a talk about **life in the Amazon**.

Then, we depart on a boat exploration to the **Yarapa River**, a tributary of the Ucayali River and a nature reserve protected by a local community.

After dark, the crew will play some live music on the board, after which we have dinner and hear about the next day's activities.





DAY 3 | MONDAY – YANALLPA STREAM / EL DORADO RIVER

We start the day before breakfast. with an optional **bird watching** activity from the deck followed by a visit to Yanallpa, a beautiful stream near the Ucayali River, where you can appreciate the vegetation and fauna.

After breakfast, we visit a school and a local village to learn about the **human culture** of the Amazon. Here, you can also acquire beautiful **handicrafts** which help sustain the community and their traditional arts.

Back at the boat, we have lunch on deck with a panoramic view of the river.

Later, a naturalist guide will offer a **talk** about the [Pacaya Samiria National Reserve](#).

After dark, we take a **night walk** around El Dorado Stream, where we can see (and hear!) the nocturnal fauna.

We then have dinner, with a briefing on the activities of the next day.

DAY 4 | TUESDAY – EL DORADO RIVER / SUPAY STREAM

We wake up early to go on a dawn boat exploration of El Dorado River, which includes the chance to fish for the iconic Amazon species: the **piranha**. Breakfast today will be a picnic on the boat, so as to enjoy the natural environment for longer.

Back at the *Amazon Star*, we have lunch and then participate in an **Amazon cooking class**.

The afternoon exploration is by boat to Supay Stream, where you have the option to explore by **kayak**.

Then, in the evening, we have dinner back on board.

DAY 5 | WEDNESDAY – DISEMBARKATION OF AMAZON STAR

We wake up early in order to disembark after breakfast, in good time to catch our outbound flight from Iquitos.
